

The Coming Ages

Review:

The Book of Revelation Timeline 2024 (1-31-2023) and Living Daily in the Spirit (1-14-2024) are the prologue to this series.

Overview:

Eph 3:20 Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do **superabundantly**, far over and above <u>all that we [dare]</u> ask or think [<u>infinitely beyond our highest prayers</u>, <u>desires</u>, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]—,

Eph 3:21 Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all **ages**, world without end. Amen.

Eph 1:20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

Eph 1:21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, **not only in this world**, but also in that which is to come:

A. Cycle of Change in the BOR.

- 1. Get on the Escalator of the Fruit of the Spirit. Love and action.
- Our Goal is the fulness of Redemption.
 Rev 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.
- 3. The method is to replace our habits with Godly ones. This is especially true of the habits we have concerning certain beliefs in and actions on specific Scriptures in the Word of God (WOG). Example 1:

We know what the WOG says. We understand why the WOG says it. It is **not** too hard to do, so we do it. [e.g., We do continue in the Word. (John 8:31, 32)] Example 2:

We know what the WOG says. We understand why the WOG says it. It is too hard to do, so we **don't** do it. [e.g., We rarely turn the other cheek. (Matt 5:39)] Example 3:

We know what the WOG says. We **don'**t understand why it says it. So, we ignore that Scripture. [e.g., It is very hard to die to self. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it. (Matt 16:25)]

B. Bible Ages.

- 1. Past: Obedience, Death, Law.
- 2. Present: Age of Grace.
- Future: Law from the End of Age of Grace. (Rev 8:1 to Rev 20:3)
 Millennial Kingdom. (Rev 20:4-10)
 New Heaven, New Earth and New Jerusalem. (Rev 20:11 to Rev 22)



C. Millennial Kingdom.

- 1. Jesus fulfills the messianic prophecies by ruling as King of kings. The overcomers, as kings and priests, help Him rule.
- 2. Jesus rules with the rod of iron. The penalty for disobedience (wages of sin) is death, so hell and death are still active and available. (Rev 20:14)
- 3. Sheep enter into the Kingdom as good seed (Matt 25:31-46). At the end, tares are cast into eternal fire (Mt 13:24-30 and 13:37-42) and the rest go into the Second Millenium with New Heaven and New Earth and New Jerusalem.

D. Changing Habits.

1. The Need to Change Habits.

Rev 22:11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

2. The Warfare.

The spiritual warfare is in the mind for control of the tongue; and the attacks are the fiery darts of the enemy and the physical cravings of the body. Your body is not your friend. It is carnal. To live carnally is to die. Rom 8:1,6,13 You have the Mind of Christ (MOC). Protect it by casting down anything that does not belong in the MOC. These include sins, memories of sins and any pleasures of which God was not a part; and the lustful (driving) desires of the body.
