

Living under Law After the Age of Grace Summary

Foundation Scriptures.

Rev 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

1 John 5:5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

1 John 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.

A. Definitions of Roles.

1. There are two types of Christians: believers and disciples: John 8:31-32.

2. **Believers** are the elect. They live in Jesus Christ with Jesus as Savior. They get deceived. They worship the beast (Rev 13:8). They die before the Rapture. **Disciples** are the very elect. They live in Christ Jesus with Jesus as Lord and feed on strong meat (Heb 5:14). They will not be deceived. They strive to be part of the Glorious Church. They become overcomers, are raptured and live in New Jerusalem (Rev 21:7, 27).

Lamb's Book of Life contains the very elect (those who are raptured), and those who are the dead in Christ, and those who are martyred.

3. All who are still alive at the Rapture will have become overcomers.

Dan 12:11 And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days. v12 Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days.

Some elect might become overcomers during the tribulation.

B. The Age of Grace.

1. When is the End of the Age of Grace?

The Age of Grace is from the Resurrection of Jesus (specifically from when Jesus poured His blood on the Mercy Seat) until the Seventh Seal.

2. How do we know?

The first six seals foretell what man is doing to man.

At the 7th seal, there is silence in Heaven for half an hour; and then the 7 trumpets are given to 7 angels. From then on, all plagues [trumpets and vials (or bowls)] are what God is doing to unrepentant man. Under the Age of Grace, God does not kill people nor put plagues on them. To the extent that it does happen, it is caused by Satan.

3 What happens at the end of the Age of Grace?

All people, believers and unbelievers go back under Law.

Heb 5:14 But strong meat belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Heb 6::1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God,

v4 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, v5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,

v6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame. So, it is mandatory to know how, as believers, we should live under law.

C. The Age of Law.

1. When does the Age of Law end?

The Age of Law ends with the Judgment Seat of Christ, which, I believe, is immediately after Armageddon. After judgment, the sheep, as good seed, enter the Millennial Kingdom (MK) and the goats are cast into eternal fire.

2. Who are alive at the end of Law?

Sheep and goats, who are unbelievers, will be alive. All believers, except the very elect, will worship the beast, which disqualifies them from becoming an overcomer so they will die; only the very elect will be raptured.

3. What happens to those remaining alive after Battle of Armageddon. The false prophet and the beast (antichrist) will be cast into Lake of Fire (Rev 19:20). And the remnant of the antichrist's army, all who took the mark of the beast **and** worshipped the beast, will be slain by the sword of the Word.

D. What Happens during the Age of Law?

1. Antichrist and his followers.

All the people of the earth, except the very elect (Heb 13:8), will worship the beast. His followers (army) will also take the mark.

2. Sheep and goats.

At least some sheep will not take the mark because they enter into the MK.

3. Believers.

Elect believers, who do not become very elect before or during the tribulation, will all worship the beast; so they will all die. However, their names are in the Book of Life, so at the Great White Throne Judgment, they will be allowed to enter into the New Earth, if they had not also taken the mark of the beast.

The very elect become the Glorious Church and live in authority and dominion during the Days of Tribulation. They became overcomers by being led by the Holy Spirit in everything including feeding on strong meat and dying to self.

Note: The acid test to know, if you are trying to be one of the very elect, is this: Are you feeding on strong meat which is moving you toward perfection (i.e., are you desiring and trying not to sin and trying to be led by the Holy Spirit in everything you think, say and do?).

E. How can believers survive until the Rapture?

1. Start now and practice to be a disciple, by continuing in the Word and so living in Christ Jesus (i.e., living with Jesus as Lord).
Luke 14:33 So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.
Protect your mind of Christ.
Live your Covenant Matrix.
2. What are the laws by which we must live?
Do not worship the beast nor take the mark of the beast.
The Ten Commandments.
Whatever the Holy Spirit tells you.
Rev 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
Note: Pro 16:5 Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the Lord:
3. How do we pray?
You are a son (adult in the family) of God and a son of man. You have authority over the earth and everything that moves on it.
You also have authority in three worlds and you are joint heirs with Jesus.
You use your authority of Mark 11:23 and Matt 18:18 and your unity with other overcomers in Matt 18:19.
What you do **not** have is access to the Name of Jesus. So, you pray based on your own faith, knowing who the Word says you are and what the Word says you have.
Ps 82:6 I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High.
John 10:34 Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?
You issue commands as a son of God and as a son of man; and as a god (a captain, a ruler, an ambassador, a manager) over the earth,
Be a very elect and use supernatural power to protect yourself.
Stay under the protection & empowerment of Rom 8:14, Ps 91 & Luke 10:19.
