

Your Glorified Body

Foundation Scriptures:

Rev 2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

Eph 3:17 Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, v18 May be able to comprehend with all saints what [is] the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; v19 And to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that ye might be **filled with all the fulness of God**.

A. Partial and Temporary Glorified Body Level 0.

1. You.

- a) Under the anointing, you first feel the peace of God; then perhaps lightness or warmth.
- b) Next progression can be to heaviness or a feeling of floating upwards.
- c) Eventually, people can see the glow on your face; perhaps you can also feel it.
- d) Finally, people are so affected by the anointing (Glory) in you that on meeting you, they might feel weak or perhaps have to be held up so they don't fall under the Spirit.

2. Biblical Examples.

- a) Exo 34:30 And when Aaron and all the children of Israel saw Moses, behold, the skin of his face shone; and they were afraid to come nigh him.
- b) Act 5:15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid [them] on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some.
- c) Act 19:12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.
- d) Act 28:3 And there came a viper out of the heat, and fastened on his hand.
Act 28:5 And he shook off the beast into the fire, and felt no harm.

B. Glorified Body Level 1.

1. This level is full not partial, but temporary (i.e., transient), and still subject to the first death.

2. Our examples are all demonstrated by Jesus.

- a) Mar 9:2 And after six days Jesus taketh [with him] Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.
Mar 9:3 And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.
Mat 17:2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.
- b) Joh 8:59 Then took they up stones to cast at him: but Jesus hid himself, and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by.
- c) Luk 4:29 And rose up, and thrust him out of the city, and led him unto the brow of the hill whereon their city was built, that they might cast him down headlong.
Luk 4:30 But he passing through the midst of them went his way,
- d) Mat 14:25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.

C. Glorified Body Level 2.

1. This is a full permanent glorified body but it is subject to the first death, as a result of a sin.

2. Adam is our example.

- a) Gen 3:6 She took of the fruit and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. v7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they [were] naked;

- b) Members of the Glorious Church before the Rapture.

D. Glorified Body Level 3.

1. This is a partial permanent glorified body. The body is glorified because it is not subject to the first death for there is no more death or hell; but it is still subject to the second death.
2. Our examples are:
 - a) Those who have survived the cleansing of the earth by fire and are now in the New Earth. These bodies require the eating of the leaves of the tree of life for healing. They may enter the New Jerusalem but they may not live in it.
 - b) Those resurrected dead whose names were written in the Lamb's Book of Life at the Great White Throne Judgment.
Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.
 - c) Those who are born in the New Earth.
 - d) Rev 22:2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, [was there] the tree of life, which bare twelve [manner of] fruits, [and] yielded her fruit every month: and the **leaves** of the tree [were] for the healing of the nations.

E. Glorified Body Level 4.

1. This is a full permanent glorified body. It is neither subject to the first death nor to the second death because it has been given a crown of life but still needs to mature into Lordship and unity.
2. Examples are: (1) the martyrs who have gone through the first death; (2) those martyrs whose works follow them (Rev 14:13); (3) possibly others, such as the dead in Christ who return with Jesus but need to grow in faith.. All of these groups would have been raised from the dead at the return of Jesus.
 - a) Rev 2:10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast [some] of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
 - b) Rev 2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

F. Glorified Body Level 5.

1. This is a full permanent glorified body and, having gone through the Rapture, is not subject to the second death and has become part of the Temple by walking in oneness with God and Jesus.
2. Our example is Jesus. Others are those who overcome by being raptured. All will eventually reach this level by growing in maturity and unity; or end up in the Lake of Fire.
 - a) Joh 20:17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and [to] my God, and your God.
 - b) Rev 1:18 I [am] he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.
 - c) Rev 3:12 Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the **temple of my God**, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, [which is] new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and [I will write upon him] my new name.
 - d) Rev 21:22 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

- b) Rev 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
