

Trumpets

Overview

Eph 5:26 Jesus wishes to sanctify and cleanse us with the washing of water by the word,

Eph 5:27 That He might **present us to Himself a glorious church**, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Col 1:27 **Christ in you is the hope of glory.**

A. Chap 8 – Trumpets 1 to 4

1. Prologue

Rev 8:1 And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour. v 8:2 And I saw the seven angels which stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets.

Rev 8:3 And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer [it] with the **prayers of all saints** upon the golden altar which was before the throne.

Rev 8:4 And the smoke of the incense, [which came] with the **prayers of the saints**, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.

Rev 8:5 And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast [it] into the earth: and there were voices, and thunderings, and lightnings, and an earthquake.

Rev 8:6 And the seven angels which had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

2. Trumpet 1

Rev 8:7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, & all green grass was burnt up.

3. Trumpet 2

Rev 8:8 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;

Rev 8:9 And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

4. Trumpet 3

Rev 8:10 And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

Rev 8:11 And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.

5. Trumpet 4

Rev 8:12 And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

6. Epilogue

Rev 8:13 And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, **Woe, woe, woe**, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

B. Chapters 9 – Trumpets 5 & 6

1. Trumpet 5

Rev 9:1 And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.

Rev 9:2 And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit.

Rev 9:3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

Pro 27:20 Hell and destruction are never full; so the eyes of man are never satisfied.

2. Trumpet 6

Rev 9:12 **One woe** is past; [and], behold, there come two woes more hereafter.

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

Rev 9:14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

Rev 9:15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

Rev 9:16 And the number of the army of the horsemen [were] two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

C. Chapter 10 – Preparing to sound the Seventh Trumpet

1. The Little Book

Rev 10:1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow [was] upon his head, and his face [was] as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

Rev 10:2 And he had in his hand a **little book** open: and he set his right foot upon the sea, and [his] left [foot] on the earth,

Rev 10:3 And cried with a loud voice, as [when] a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

Rev 10:4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

2. The Glorious Church.

Rev 10:5 And the angel which I saw stand upon the sea and upon the earth lifted up his hand to heaven, v 10:6 And swore by him that liveth for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that therein are, and the earth, and the things that therein are, and the sea, and the things which are therein, that there should be **time no longer**:

Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound, the **mystery of God should be finished**, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.

Col 1:26 [Even] the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:

Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you, the hope of glory**:

Col 1:28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man **perfect** in Christ Jesus:

Eph 4:11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; v 4:12 For the **perfecting** of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

Eph 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a **perfect** man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

Rom 5:8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. v 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be **saved from wrath** through him. v 5:10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

3. Sealing the Little Book

Rev 10:4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

Rev 10:8 And the voice which I heard from heaven spake unto me again, and said, Go [and] take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel which standeth upon the sea and upon the earth.

Rev 10:9 And I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take [it], and eat it up; and it shall make thy belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth sweet as honey.

Rev 10:10 And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was bitter.

4. Unsealing the Little Book

Dan 10:14 Now I am come to make thee understand what shall befall thy people in the latter days: for yet the vision [is] for [many] days.

Dan 12:2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame [and] everlasting contempt.

Dan 12:3 And **they that be wise** shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

Dan 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, [even] **to the time of the end**: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Mat 24:32 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer [is] nigh:

Mat 24:33 So ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, [even] at the doors.

Mat 24:34 Verily I say unto you, **This generation shall not pass**, till all these things be fulfilled.

Mat 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

1Co 10:11 Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.

Hab 2:2 And the LORD answered me, and said, **Write the vision, and make [it] plain** upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.

D. Chapter 11 – The sounding of the Seventh Trumpet

1. The re-building of the Temple

Rev 11:1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein.

Rev 11:2 But the **court which is without the temple leave out**, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot **forty [and] two months**.

2. The Two Witnesses – Two of the Glorious Church

Rev 11:3 And I will give [power] unto my two witnesses, and they shall **prophesy** a thousand two hundred [and] threescore days, clothed in sackcloth. (*3 ½ years @ 30 days per month*)

Rev 11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth. v 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth**, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed. v 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.

2Ki 1:10 And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I [be] a man of God, then let **fire come down from heaven, and consume thee** and thy fifty. And there came down fire from heaven, and consumed him and his fifty.

Note: The world is no longer under Grace. We are under the Law but with the Holy Spirit.

3. Follow-on fruits

Rev 11:7 And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies [shall lie] in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, **where also our Lord was crucified.**

Rev 11:9 And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.

Rev 11:10 And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

Rev 11:11 **And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them,** and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them. v 11:12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them. v 11:13 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

Rev 11:14 **The second woe** is past; [and], behold, the third woe cometh quickly.

Rom 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the **firstborn among many brethren.**

1Co 15:20 But now is Christ risen from the dead, [and] become the firstfruits of them that slept.

1Co 15:21 For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise first:**

4. The kingdoms of this world

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The **kingdoms of this world** are become [the kingdoms] of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 11:16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God, v 11:17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Rev 11:18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. v 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Mat 22:44 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; v 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.

Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath **perfected** for ever them that are sanctified.

5. The last enemy

1Co 15:24 Then [cometh] the end, **when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God,** even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.

1Co 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1Co 15:26 The last enemy [that] shall be destroyed [is] death.

2Ti 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath **abolished death,** and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

Daily End Times Prayers

Heavenly Father,

This day, in the Name of Jesus, I loose upon this world Your will, Your power and Your angels to have Your way upon the earth this day. In the Name of Jesus, I bind satan and all his demons, devils and evil spirits from trying to hinder, delay, obstruct or even disobey God's angels as they implement God's will upon the earth today.

In the Name of Jesus, I loose God's will, His power and His angels to accomplish this day and every day the following seven declarations, which are to:

- 1) Ensure that the Gospel of Jesus Christ has been taught and continues to be ministered to every person on earth, including all the children, in one or more of the following ways: by Jesus Himself, by angels, by Christians, by Christians who have been translated to do so, and by nature such as animals, plants, rocks, mountains, etc preaching the Word of God.
- 2) Protect every Jew especially the Rabbis; protect every Christian especially those in the five fold ministries; and those Jews and Christians in countries and/or areas of persecution; and most especially the Christian missionaries; and to teach all Jews and Christians the Gospel of Protection. *(Here I normally insert specific names and ministries and the people to whom they are ministering e.g. Mark and Astrid and the Karin and Kachin people)*
- 3) Maintain a sphere of protection around the USA and Israel so that no weapon formed against them shall prosper but every plane, rocket and missile launched against them shall be destroyed or neutralized before they enter United States or Israeli air space.
- 4) Keep torn down and powerless within the USA the principalities, powers, might and dominions, including the rulers of darkness and spiritual wickedness from high places, of abortion, pornography, adultery/fornication/homosexuality, human trafficking, satanic human and animal sacrifices; and keep torn down and destroyed all the satanic high places and satanic altars of worship.
- 5) Ensure that the Gospel of Jesus Christ is preached to every member of government within the USA from the city, county and state levels to all branches of the Federal Government including Congress, the US Supreme Court and the Executive Branch including the president and his cabinet and to the relatives of all these government employees; that the ministers of this Gospel to each of these people be persons to whom each will show respect and attention; that the Holy Spirit will soften each heart and woo each mind so they are prepared to receive the Gospel; and that the Holy Spirit leads them all in all their decision-makings which affect the US and its people.
- 6) Assign additional angels to assist the guardian angels of all the children around the entire world; and we command the guardian angels and all these additional angels to provide to all the children food, drink, clothing, shelter and miraculous protection and/or deliverance from

abusive and dangerous situations including warfare; and to provide similar help to all those who accompany the children and to their legal parents/guardians.

7) Provide food, drink, clothing, and protection to the widows, orphans, homeless and the hungry and needy; and to do so in miraculous manners, if necessary
