

Grace after the Age of Grace

Overview.

Adam (mankind) was created to be a god over the earth. The Last Adam has restored everything; so, we are, as according to Ps 82:6, gods over the earth. We have authority in our own right over the earth and all that is on it. As joint heirs with Jesus, we also have authority over everything which exists. As we say, so it is written and so it is done. Those associated with ABC have raised 9 from the dead.

Review.

A. From: Communion in the Ending Days.

1. By His one sacrifice of His body and Blood, he restored mankind back to what God had created them to be. He undid what Adam lost and gave us much more by the Blood Covenant of the New Testament.
2. He has restored us to that right of being the Glorious Church:
A church that can sin but chooses not to do so.
A church that can die but is holding fast to their Crown of Life (Rev 3:11).

B. From: Living as the Glorious Church.

1. The Age of Grace provides us the time and opportunity to be saved, to grow into our restored godship and to mature into all the blessings of our Salvation Package. The Glorious Church has already been restored. Members of the Glorious Church already have their names written in the Lamb's Book of Life.
2. The Glorious Church.
Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected forever them that are sanctified.
Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
This presentation to Himself is the Rapture.

A. The Wilderness Experience.

1. Filtering: Joshua and Caleb, 2 of 3 million Hebrews entered the Promised Land.
This foreshadows the 1000 years reign; so projection: 2000 of 3 billion believers.
2. Living in the Wilderness.

40 years wilderness	2000 years today
Delivered from slavery	Delivered from bondage of sin
Ate manna	Eat Communion
Led by cloud and fire	Led by the WOG and Holy Spirit
Believed the promise of taking the Promised Land	Believe the promises to be the Glorious Church – Sanctification, Perfection, Never die, immortality
Faith produced grace & miracles to enter the Land	Faith will produce grace to be alive and remain and live forever

B. Perfection.

1. Heb 5:14 But strong meat belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses **exercised to discern both good and evil**.
 Heb 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; *(one doctrine of Christ is praying in the Name of Jesus)*.
 Heb 10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.
 Eph 1: 19 *and to know* what is the exceeding greatness of his power **towards us** who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,
 Eph 3: 19 And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. *This precedes v20*.
2. Jesus lived and ministered as Son of Man. We are sons of man.
 We are conformed to His image (Rom 8:30) and we do greater works (Jn 14:12).
 The problem is that everything not of faith is sin (Rom 14:23).
 The solution is to be under grace at all times. To do that we must be acting in faith at all times i.e., led by the Word or the Holy Spirit. (Rom 8:13,14)
 We mortify the flesh by being led by the Spirit, by orchestrating our lives using the **Interval Living Matrix**, so it becomes our ramp into the Ark of Anointing.

C. Grace Under the Ages of Death and Law.

The word "Grace" is used in the OT 37 times.

1. Age of Death.

Gen 5:24 Enoch walked in agreement with God and was taken.
 Rom 4:3 For what saith the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.
 Gen 18:23 And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?
 Heb 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.
 Gen 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

2. Age of Law.

Joshua 10:12 Then spoke Joshua and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.
 2 Kings 1:10 And Elijah answered and said to the captain of fifty, If I be a man of God, then let fire come down from heaven, and consume thee and thy fifty
 Num 20:8 ... and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink.
 Num 20:10 And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?
 Num 20:11 And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also.

D. The Glorious Church (GC).

1. GC Under Grace.

The expression "In my Name" is used 17 times but only in the Gospels.

Only 7 times is it used for prayer (ask) and all are in John in chapters 14-16, where he is preparing his disciples for His death and for the Age of Grace.

John 14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

John 14:14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Luke 18:8 Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth? (Faith to believe the promises. Death has been abolished. We shall not all die. We have been perfected and sanctified. Sons of God are led by the Spirit. We mortify the flesh by being spirit-led).

Matt 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect (*those not feeding on strong meat and moving towards perfection*).

2. GC Under Law.

The Name of Jesus is no longer available to us

Salvation is no longer available by grace, through calling upon His Name.

Rom 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Rev 19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

v13 And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called the Word of God.

Characteristics of the GC.

Walk in love and power. Choose not to sin. Reject offense and are givers. Great control over tongue. Strong in the Fruit of the Spirit. Great discernment.

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

Note: All will be deceived except the very elect, who are walking in strong meat moving onto perfection and whose names are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

Rev 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, fire proceeds out of their mouth, and devours their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

How the GC Prays.

Mark 11:22 Have the God-like faith.

Mark 23 Live a lifestyle where you believe that every word you speak, shall come to pass. You said it. So it is written. So it is done.

Mark 11:24 Believe that you create and receive everything that you say/pray.

Mark 11:25-26 Believe that you receive back manifold everything you sow including offense and unforgiveness, which can turn people over to the torturers.
